2022 WASHINGTON YOUTH TOUR PROGRAM

Two deserving high school juniors from the West Kentucky RECC service area will be awarded an expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C. on **June 17-23**, **2022** as participants in the Washington Youth Tour Program sponsored jointly by West Kentucky RECC and the Kentucky Association of Electric Cooperatives. West Kentucky RECC has sponsored the Washington Youth Tour Program for 24 years.

Youth Tour winners will spend a week along with many other Kentucky youth touring Monticello, the Smithsonian Institute, Arlington National Cemetery, National Cathedral, Library of Congress, U.S. Capitol, and the White House and will visit with Kentucky's congressional delegation.

To be eligible, students must be between their junior and senior years in high school and no older than 18 at the time of the trip. Students' parent or guardian must be a member of West Kentucky RECC and receive electric service at their principle place of residence from West Kentucky RECC. In addition, each Youth Tour participant must complete an application form, receive a favorable report from their guidance counselor and a high school teacher, be involved in school and community activities, complete an essay and agree to abide by the terms and conditions as specified by West Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation.

If you are interested in applying for West Kentucky RECC's 2022 Washington Youth Tour, fill out the attached application form and mail it to Georgann Lookofsky, West Kentucky RECC, P.O. Box 589, Mayfield, Kentucky, 42066. All materials must be submitted by March 11, 2022.

Please note, participating students will need a negative COVID test two days prior to leaving for Washington, D.C. Temperatures will be taken each morning. COVID tests will be available for those students who feel sick. COVID quarantine hotel rooms will be available and there will be nurses on staff.

WEST KENTUCKY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION 2022 YOUTH TOUR PROGRAM - RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

- 1. Students who are currently juniors in high school, and whose parent(s) or guardian is a member of and receives electric service from West Kentucky RECC at their primary place of residence are eligible to apply. Children of West Kentucky RECC employees and directors are not eligible.
- 2. Participants must be between their junior and senior years in high school (at the time of the trip) and no older than 18 at the time of the trip.
- 3. West Kentucky RECC will sponsor two students to the 2022 Washington Youth Tour.
- 4. Eligible students must receive a written favorable recommendation from their guidance counselor and a high school teacher. (See attached form.)
- 5. YOUTH TOUR AWARD: Two winners will receive an expense-paid, week-long trip to our Nation's Capital as members of the Washington Youth Tour. The 2020 Washington Youth Tour is scheduled for **June 17-23**, **2022**.
- 6. Each participant must submit:
 - Completed West Kentucky RECC WYT Application Form
 - Recent photo
 - Guidance counselor written recommendation
 - High school teacher written recommendation
 - Typewritten 500-word essay on the following topic:

"What makes you a good candidate to represent WKRECC on the 2022 Youth Tour and what do you expect to gain from your Washington, D.C. experience?"

- All materials must be submitted to Georgann Lookofsky at West Kentucky RECC, P. O. Box 589, Mayfield, KY 42066, by *March 11, 2022*. This information will become the property of West Kentucky and will not be returned.
- 6. Essays will be judged on the basis of originality, composition, grammar and neatness.
- 7. The winners will be recognized at the Cooperative's Annual Meeting on July 11, 2022.
- 9. For clarification, West Kentucky RECC defines an eligible student as:

A) a student who, in all probability, will be promoted at the completion of this academic year

B) who has established as excellent academic record in high school

C) has been actively involved in extracurricular activities

D) has demonstrated leadership abilities through community activities

E) has, in the view of school officials, the inclination to be a serious, enthusiastic and well-behaved youth tour participant.
